Hearts, bones, muscles and tendons become tools to understand humanity as part of Nature and the Divine. Contributions by anatomist Mario Rende further explore the medical and scientific value of Leonardo’s studies, highlighting his experimental method, innovative approach and philosophical vision of the human body.
